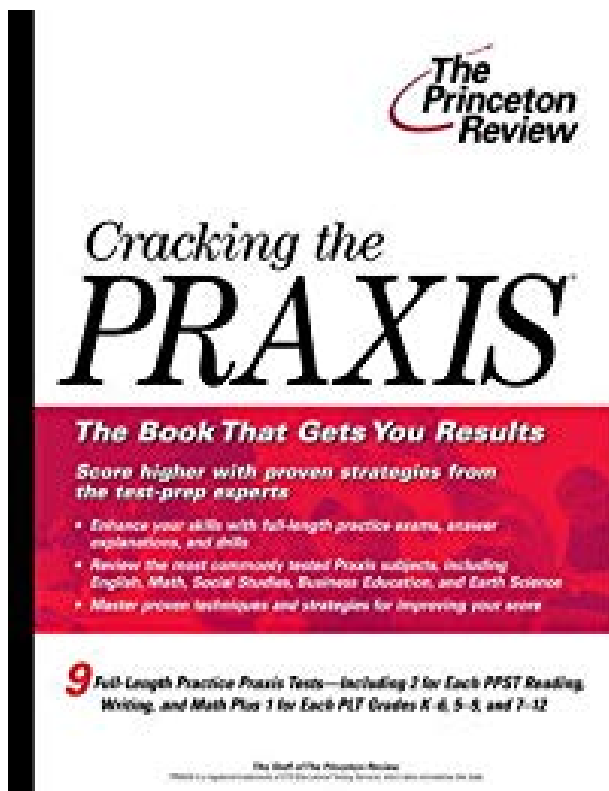


Cracking the PRAXIS
